#### **ACADEMIC BURSARY**

Curtin College offers several bursaries to support you financially:

Curtin College Academic Bursary: AUD \$2,000 deduction on the first intake tuition fee for new Malaysian and Indonesian international students commencing programs in 2025.

**Diploma Pathway Academic Bursary – Only for Bhutan:** AUD \$2,000 deduction enrolling in diploma programs.

Master Qualifying Program Bursary: Maximum of AUD \$1,500 for new international students from Bhutan, Cambodia, and Sri Lanka enrolling in the Master Qualifying Program.

Navitas Family Bursary: 10% tuition fee reduction for the second and subsequent family members.



# HIGH ACHIEVER SCHOLARSHIP

Available to all new international students enrolled in any Curtin College Diploma program who have achieved a course weighted average of 65%.

It covers 15% of any study period. You may also be eligible for a scholarship in Year 2 at Curtin University if you meet the scholarship criteria.\*
