You have a concern about a student's mental health

Make a referral to the correct person once you have a clearer idea of needs:

- > Seeking a Learning Access Plan: refer to Student learning Advisor (Mojoy)
- > Academic issues such as deferrals or withdrawal: refer to the Program Manager
- > Mental health concerns that are not immediate and the student can wait for an appointment use referral form for Student Counsellor (Rubie)
- > health and Medical issues: Refer to Curtin Health Services
