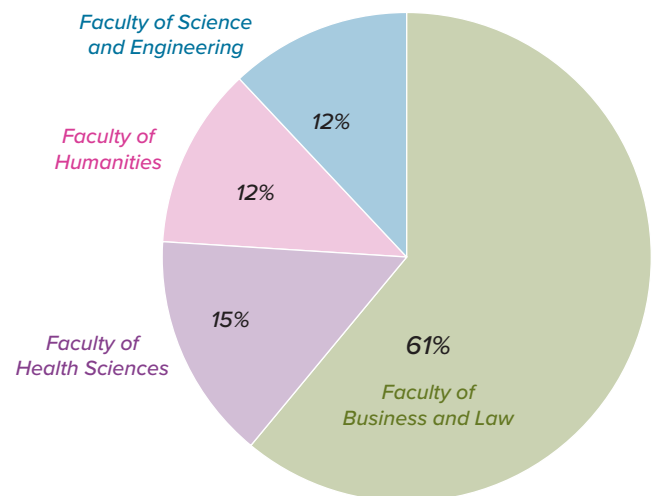
Masters Qualifying Program (MQP) At A Glance

Who is the Master Qualifying Program (MQP) for?

- Students aiming to attain a Curtin University Master's degree
- Students seeking a more personalised learning experience
- Individuals who do not meet Curtin University's minimum entry requirements
- Graduates who have completed a bachelor's degree
- Mature age students looking for an alternative pathway to university
- Exclusive for International Students only

The Master Qualifying Program (MQP) is a one-semester non-award program designed for International Students who already have a tertiary qualification but who do not qualify for direct entry into a Master's degree at Curtin University. The emphasis is on developing the skills necessary to succeed in postgraduate-level studies.

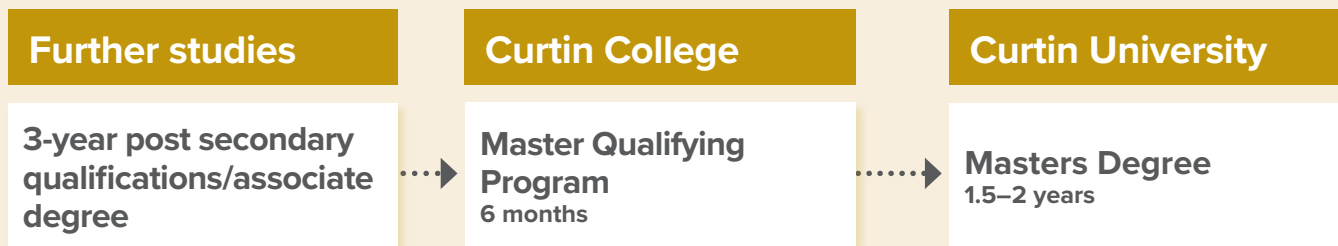

Program Structure

The MQP is made up of 4 (pre-postgraduate) units studied over 1 semester. Three (3) core units, and one (1) elective.

Core Units

Academic Communication for Postgraduate Studies

The unit aims to develop the productive and receptive skills required for communicating at a postgraduate level. Practical in nature, it focuses on academic conventions related to the different modes of academic communication. The unit encompasses the use of strategies to develop the academic voice by honing on analytical and critical thinking skills. Through tasks that will enhance intrapersonal and interpersonal skills, this unit assists in the application of communication skills and knowledge in both the academic and professional contexts.

Intercultural Perspectives for Postgraduate Studies

This unit aims to provide intercultural perspectives within a cross-cultural context to develop post graduate communication, writing and research skills. Through the application of cross-cultural theory and multicultural frameworks, employability competencies such as interpersonal skills, cultural awareness and analytical skills will be explored. The unit facilitates how to effectively manage transitions between different cultural contexts through a process of self-awareness, peer review and reflection.

Research Skills for Postgraduate Studies

The unit aims to develop knowledge and skills for conducting research at a postgraduate level. This includes an introduction to the principles of human inquiry and a selection of quantitative and qualitative research methodologies. Research design, methods, analysis, ethics and outcomes to advance critical and analytical thinking, information processing and evidence-based interpretation that build the foundational support for future research undertakings will be explored. The unit develops knowledge and skill in locating and evaluating evidence and information sources for research purposes.

Electives

Project Management for Postgraduates*

This unit introduces key project management concepts using the PMBOK® Guide. Students will learn how to plan projects, lead teams, and manage tasks through all stages, from initiation to closure. The unit also focuses on communication, reporting, collaboration, and leadership skills.

**This Unit is required for entry into ALL Masters, except: Master of Computing, Master of Predictive Analytics and Master of Science in Agriculture and Food Security.*

Fundamentals of Analytical Programming#

This unit covers basic programming and mathematical skills needed for postgraduate study in data science. Students will explore topics like linear algebra, data analysis, and statistics using modern programming tools.

#Required for entry into: Master of Computing, Master of Predictive Analytics and Master of Science in Agriculture and Food Security

Dedicated Academic Support

Academic Success Program

This unit is a dedicated two hours per week support at no additional cost. The unit aims to develop academic skills and language proficiency required to participate fully and succeed in MQP. It focuses on identifying and understanding the academic demands and conventions in completing assignments. This is accomplished by developing an awareness of discipline discourse for clarity and impact.

Completion of a three-year post-secondary qualification (post-Year 12 equivalent), OR

A Bachelor's degree (or equivalent) from a recognised university, comparable to an AQF Associate Degree; &

English proficiency: IELTS overall 6.0 (no band below 5.5)

***For the Master of TESOL 6.0 (no band less than 6.0)*
