- Census date will be Friday, 16 January 2026. Withdrawing from a unit after this date will result in no refund of fees paid. A 70% refund will apply to withdrawals made prior to this date.
- Withdrawals after the Census date will appear as a withdrawal (W) result on the transcript. Withdrawals after 30 January 2026 will appear as a fail (F) on the transcript.
- If the unit does not meet the required number of students for teaching it will be cancelled and a full refund given.
