## St Catherine's College

Located in the heart of the new Curtin Exchange precinct, you'll have access to a boutique grocer, cafes, restaurants and retail outlets right at your doorstep.

St Catherine's College offers a premium and welcoming home away from home. The College is fully catered with a range of meal options. St Cat's has a thriving academic, social and intellectual culture, including a comprehensive academic support and career readiness program and a full social, sporting and volunteering events calendar.

The College includes a Dining Hall, common rooms, study rooms, an innovation hub, music practice rooms, a micro theatre, a sky lounge, a games room and a roof garden.

#### **Erica Underwood House**

Sitting across the road from the campus and a three-minute walk from shops and restaurants, Erica Underwood House embodies the student experience.

It has 54 furnished, six-bedroom apartments, which accommodate a total of 324 students. There is a communal atmosphere, with a shared common room and large outdoor areas to unwind with friends after a day of study.

## **Guild House**

Guild House is located across the road from Curtin Stadium, and in close proximity to Waterford Plaza and Curtin Exchange, giving students easy access to a variety of food and retail outlets.

There are 202 private rooms available across 35 four- and sixbedroom apartments.

## **Kurrajong Village**

Our campus village is located on the west side of Curtin Perth, opposite Waterford Plaza shopping centre. There are four properties available within the tranquil gardens.

Depending on the room type you choose, you'll be able to stay in two, six or eight-bedroom apartments, or studio apartments, including ensuite options. Our eight-bedroom apartments are Curtin Perth's best budget option.

## **Vickery House**

On the southeast boundary of Curtin Perth, Vickery House offers 42 furnished, single-storey six- and eight-bedroom units.

The accommodation is a short walk from the Curtin University Bus Station, which connects to the Curtin Exchange precinct, the city and to train stations.

**Cost** From \$242 per week





## **Twin Dolphin Hall**

Twin Dolphin Hall is UniLodge's newest student accommodation at Curtin University. The 10-storey halls of residence is located in Curtin Perth's Exchange precinct.

There are self-contained studios and one-bedroom options – many of which feature extra space to allow for accessibility needs – as well as multi-share rooms for two, four and six people. There are also specialty common spaces on each level for you to relax or study with friends.

Please note that the demand for accommodation is high in Australia. We recommend arranging your accommodation well before you arrive in Perth to start your studies.

Students under the age of 18 must have accommodation and welfare arrangements approved by Curtin College prior to leaving their home country.

This is a requirement of Australia Immigration. Curtin College can approve arrangements for students living with parents, legal guardians and relatives nominated by a parent/legal guardian of the student.

The guardian must be over the age of 21 and must be of good character which is shown by providing a police clearance of the countries in which they have lived in for more than 12 months in the past 10 years after the age of 16. If there is no guardian available, students under the age of 18 must reside in Homestay Accommodation.
